

Dear Friends,

None of us could have failed to notice how much the natural world around us has been suffering due to the lack of water this summer, with perhaps the increased prospect of flooding as we approach the colder months. I planted some potatoes in our garden, but this



year the resulting potatoes have been small and somewhat shrivelled! Some farmers are experiencing further problems because they have been unable to recruit enough workers to harvest the crops.

Although he was a carpenter by trade, Jesus understood that many of those who gathered to listen to him had lives that were closely bound up with the land.



In chapter 9 of the Gospel of Matthew Jesus said to those who followed him: "The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest." Jesus was not necessarily talking about having a farming recruitment drive! He often used stories about farming (sowing seeds, tending vineyards etc) to talk about God's concern for his people and how we might respond to gather the message of his love and share this in our communities.

As the holiday period ends, schools return, and all our work, cares and concerns of life continue, we are reminded again about the changing seasons at this traditional time of harvest and what is known in the church as 'Creationtide'. This is an especially good time to look at how we can each celebrate and care a little more for the precious natural resources we all need, but also to care for nature 'for nature's sake' alone. You are welcome to join in this celebrating at one of our Harvest Festival services on September 25<sup>th</sup>.





# You Can Do IT! Project









In today's society, technology has transformed our lives, and many of us could no longer imagine living without it. Although those digitally-skilled take these changes in their stride, it is clear that those who are used to more physical forms of life such as paper forms, face-to-face meetings, and physical photographs can struggle to adapt.

At Bedsrcc we recognised the need to provide a service to people who need help using digital technology. In February this year, we launched our **You Can Do IT!** project. **You Can Do IT!** is a digital inclusion project which improves people's lives by getting them online and accessing services and systems that will improve their health and wellbeing. During the sessions, participants are shown how to use their smartphones, tablets, or laptops to carry out tasks such as joining an online activity group, shopping, making video calls to friends and family, and more.

#### **Bill Simmons, Digital Lead says:**

"Aside from learning how to book a GP appointment online or re-order medication using an app, the smaller things often feel the most heartwarming and rewarding. From helping a grandmother to see her grandchildren abroad via a video call, or from scanning utility bills with a tablet so they can be read aloud, or discovering music online, these things can help improve someone's sense of health and wellbeing too.

**You Can Do IT**'s groups often turn frowns into smiles or even laughter, I think everyone in any position in our groups benefits from being part of it."

Not only does the **YCDIT!** project benefit those who attend the sessions as participants, they also help give purpose to the Digital Health Champions, who without, the sessions couldn't happen.

### Jonathan Jones, Volunteer Digital Health Champion says:

"After taking early retirement I was looking for something that would enable me to use my professional skills in a way that could help the wider community. Getting involved with the project has been immensely beneficial as it has given me a much needed sense of purpose, brought me into a very positive environment and given me the opportunity to meet a wide range of very friendly people."

We now have four groups running in Biggleswade, Putnoe, Dunstable and Houghton Regis. Over the next two years, new groups will be added across Bedfordshire.
