WHAT DO VOLUNTEERS DO?

Over the past year we have made repeated requests for volunteers to come and join our happy band. And by and large we have been successful. As well as recruiting drivers we have also managed to welcome new phone holders ie those folk who receive calls for help and then try, usually successfully, to find a volunteer willing to undertake the task required. No doubt some of you will have wondered what these volunteering tasks entail and we thought it might be useful to give villagers some simple figures to illustrate this. Over the last quarter ended on 30th June 2022 the tasks carried were:

- Health Transport lifts to GP, hospital, dentist, optician, physiotherapy etc - 32
- Social well being transport lifts to hairdresser, family, shops, visiting hospital, hospice etc - 28
- * Collection and delivery of shopping 1
- * Befriending 2 clients
- * Fortnightly Tea & Chat approximately 10 per session

And during the height of the pandemic the number of tasks carried out by volunteers, especially prescription collection and delivery, was significant. In the quarter ended 23rd June 2020 195 folk were helped in one way or another. The help and support all volunteers provide, in whatever guise, is very much appreciated!

This article is being written when the country is beginning the week of mourning following the death of Queen Elizabeth II. The CGNS offers our heartfelt condolences to the Royal Family at this sad time and looks forward to the reign of King Charles III as he begins the challenge of a lifetime.


