Please join with me in prayer for King Charles III and the royal family on this important occasion. Long live the king!

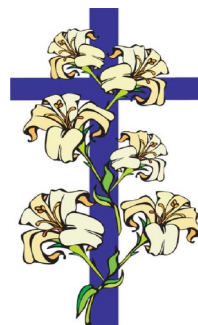
