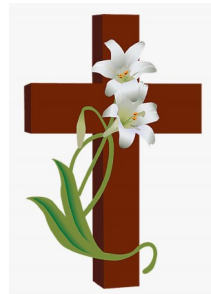

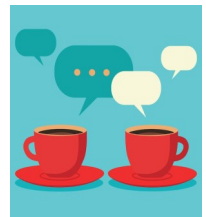

This week we had the second of our two open evenings for Year 8 students who are thinking of applying to the school for September 2024. Both events went extremely well and visiting families were full of praise for how passionate and knowledgeable our students were. 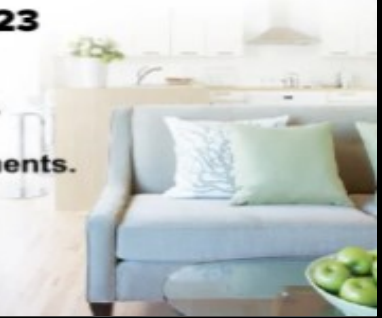

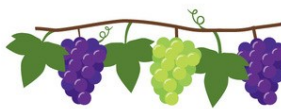
